School Improvements.

Over the summer holidays the classrooms & corridor of the school were freshly painted. It was lovely to return to a bright, fresh building.

A fully interactive Clevertouch screen was installed in each classroom. The screens are bright and engaging and greatly enhance teaching and learning.

Through funding granted by the Department of Education & Youth, Solar Panels were installed on both front and back of the school roof. We have a monitor installed in the corridor which allows children to see how much energy is generated by the panels and consumed in the school. This will help us become more Environmentally Aware and reduce energy bills.

Supporting Charities
